

## Links to other subject units this term

Link to **geography** 'What a Wonderful World' as we explore the invention of the aeroplane by The Wright Brothers. We can use maps / globe / atlases to locate the continent of America and set it in its geographical context with where we live.

## Prior Learning

The children will, in Year 1, have used a variety of different sources e.g. photographs and pictures to find out about the past. They will have, with guidance, sequenced pictures and simple events from the past.

## Learning Sequence

How has transport changed?	<ul> <li>Find out about the different ways in which travel and transport has changed from the past to the present using pictorial evidence</li> </ul>	
Early travel: The Viking Longboats	<ul> <li>Find out about an early form of transport: The Viking Longboat</li> <li>Know where this form of transport fits within a chronology framework</li> <li>Ask and answer questions, using a variety of sources - pictures, Internet searches etc- to show that they know and understand key features of events (In the context of finding out about the Viking longboats and how they were used effectively)</li> </ul>	
A History of Cars	Find out about how cars have changed since they were invented	
George Stephenson and Trains	<ul> <li>Develop an awareness of the lives of significant individuals (George Stephenson) who have contributed to national and international achievements.</li> </ul>	

A History of Flight	<ul> <li>Discuss how the invention of the train impacted upon the lives of the people of that time (in the 19<sup>th</sup> century by finding out about George Stephenson's life and inventions.</li> <li>Find out about the different ways that humans have tried to fly throughout history.</li> <li>Find out about the Wright brothers and the invention of the aeroplane.</li> </ul>
