Literal Questions – fiction, poetry and non-fiction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be able to understand the text read. To answer questions using full sentences and words from the question. To use scanning techniques to quickly find answers including those not in the order of the text. To highlight the key words to help format an answer.
Prediction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To predict what might happen from details stated and begin to predict on what is implied.
Summarizing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To identify main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph and summarize these.
Understanding vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To ask questions to improve the understanding of a text. To expand on known vocabulary through the learning of new synonyms.
General Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read independently by checking that the text makes sense and explain the meaning of words in context. Participate in discussion about relevant books that are read to me and those I can read for myself, taking turns and listening to what others say.
