Learning Sequence

How and why do people of faith worship?

- To describe different ways people may worship
- To recognise aspects of worship common to more than one faith
- To reflect on the importance of worship in the life of a believer

How is a place of worship used?

- To name the parts of two places of worship for different faiths
- To describe how the building and its artefacts are used in different ways

What makes a holy book special?

- To say why religious people celebrate an important life event
- To recognise and name the holy books of different faiths
- To retell a story from two different faiths and say what they mean for the believer

What signs tell us that Easter is coming and how do they make us feel?
What are the big surprises of Easter?
How do Christians prepare for Easter?
What traditions

- To read a simple version of the Easter story, focusing on Holy Week and Jesus coming back to life
- To use the senses to explore artefacts and symbols associated with Easter time
- - Shrove Tuesday (pancakes)
- - Ash Wednesday (ash crosses)
- - Lent (giving things up)
- - Mothering Sunday (cards and gifts for Mum)
- - Palm Sunday (palm crosses)
- - Good Friday (hot cross buns)
- - Easter Day (chocolate eggs)
