Learning Sequence	
How has transport changed?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find out about the different ways in which travel and transport has changed from the past to the present using pictorial evidence
Early travel: The Viking Longboats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find out about an early form of transport: The Viking Longboat Know where this form of transport fits within a chronology framework Ask and answer questions, using a variety of sources - pictures, Internet searches etc- to show that they know and understand key features of events (In the context of finding out about the Viking longboats and how they were used effectively)
A History of Cars	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find out about how cars have changed since they were invented
George Stephenson and Trains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop an awareness of the lives of significant individuals (George Stephenson) who have contributed to national and international achievements.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss how the invention of the train impacted upon the lives of the people of that time (in the 19th century by finding out about George Stephenson's life and inventions.
A History of Flight	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find out about the different ways that humans have tried to fly throughout history. • Find out about the Wright brothers and the invention of the aeroplane.
Comparing the Past, Present and Future	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss how travel and transport was different in the past and will continue to develop in the future. • Compare travel and transport of the past, present and future.
Assessment milestones	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To demonstrate understanding of the ways in which travel and transport has changed throughout history (A / B / C) • To use a variety of sources (pictorial, Internet research) to find out about innovations in transport through time (B / C / E) • To recall key facts about different types of travel and transport and the significant people involved in inventing them (B) • To understand the chronology of the different points in history when various types of transport have been invented and why (B / C)
