

## **Prior Learning**

This unit will build on the knowledge and skills learned in KS1

Prior learning will be knowledge of other artists and how to use pencil (colouring neatly and showing different tones), paint (mixing primary colours to produce secondary colours, adding white and black to make tints and tones, pattern and texture by adding dots and lines of different sizes and thickness), print (overlapping and repeating shapes and using objects to create print) and collage (sort and arranging a combination of materials that are cut, torn and glued to create texture) which will be built on to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills.
