Learning Sequence

The Outbreak of War	 To explain why World War II began and order events from early World War II on a timeline.
Evacuation	To write a letter in role as an evacuee from World War II
Rationing	 To describe how people's diets were different during World War II and answer questions about the implementation of rationing.

The Role of Women	To find out about women's wartime jobs and describe what they entailed in detail.
The Holocaust	Explain what the Holocaust was and describe some events that happened.
Key Events	 To describe what happened during some key events from World War II and order events on a timeline.
